

Decrease youth smoking rates by:

• Supporting community efforts for counter tobacco point-of-sale strategies at the local level

Protect Hoosiers from exposure to secondhand smoke by:

- Supporting local and/or statewide smoke-free air ordinances for worksites, including restaurants, bars and gaming facilities
- Working toward smoke-free policies in multi-unit housing
